P Transport and parking

Public transport

Bus stops are located along Hospital Avenue and Monash Avenue. To plan your individual journey:

- visit the **Travel Smart Junction** located at the QEII/MC
- use the Transperth journey planner at www.transperth.wa.gov.au
- call Transperth on **13 62 13**

Paid parking

Car parks closest to PCH:

- Access to the wards and Emergency – the PCH basement car parks (entrance off Hospital Avenue, southern end).
- Outpatient appointments – the QEII/MC multi deck car park (entrance via the traffic lights on Winthrop Avenue).

Drop off / Pick up

There is a short term patient Drop off / Pick up near the Main Entrance and Emergency Entrance.

These car bays are available for 15 minute pick up and drop off purposes only.

Bicycle storage

Bicycle racks are available close to the PCH Main Entrance.

Concession parking

In some specific instances you may be eligible for concession parking. Please speak to your treatment team for more information.

Parking for larger vehicles

Parking for larger vehicles is available at any open air car parks.

Taxi service

The taxi rank is located across Hospital Avenue outside the E Block, SCGH.

Free buggy service

For assistance getting from the multi deck car park to PCH Main Entrance, you can catch the free buggy. Please call the driver on 0481 438 731 for collection and access for prams.

Lifts

The lift bays are brightly coloured and service specific areas of the hospital. After-hours access is restricted and you may need to use an intercom to access certain areas.

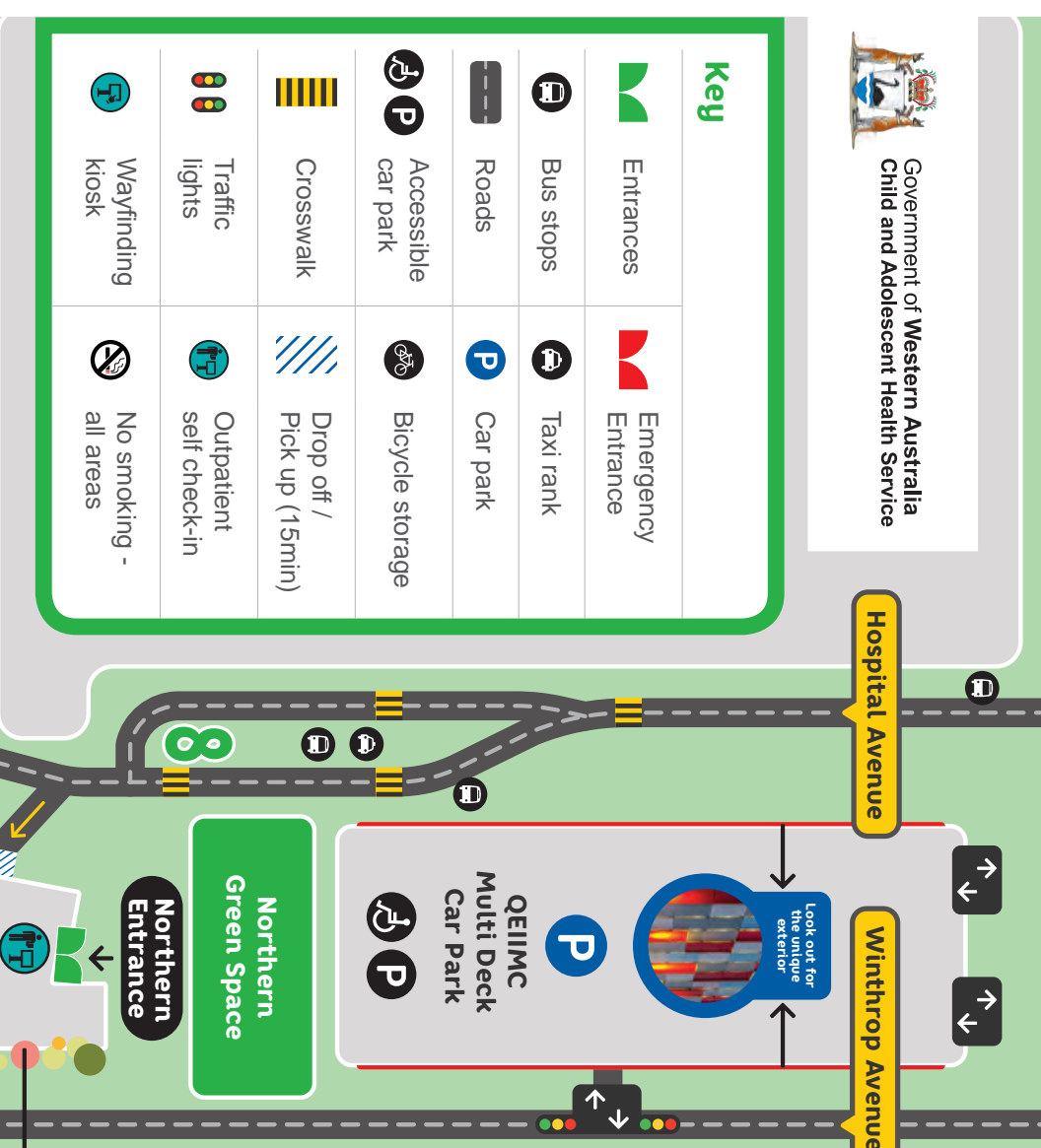
Green lifts service the ward areas, Clinic H, Clinic J and basement car parks only. If you need to access other parts of the hospital you must change lifts on the Ground Level.

Pink lifts service outpatient clinics, surgical admissions, cafes and the Fun on Four recreation and play area.

Yellow lifts service the food hall, PCH Foundation offices and the Telethon Kids Institute.
