This communiqué highlights key discussions from the Board's November 2018 meeting as well as other important information.

November 2018 Board Meeting

The tenth Board Meeting for 2018 was held on 23 November 2018 at the Perth Children's Hospital (PCH).

Appointment of Chief Executive

The Board congratulated Dr Aresh Anwar on his appointment as the Chief Executive, Child and Adolescent Health Service.

Patient Experience

• The Board discussed a patient's experience in relation to Emergency Surgery at PCH (Patient Opinion), and the CAHS response.

The Board received reports from its three Standing Committees as follows:

Safety and Quality

- The Chair of the Safety and Quality Committee provided an overview of items discussed at the13 November meeting, including:
 - the request for an updated report on ED wait times for paediatric mental health patients in May 2019;
 - o the improvement in SAC 1 investigations completed;
 - the Board Chair and Deputy Chair discussing incorporating opportunities to participate in quality improvement with academic partners.

Finance

- The Chair of the Finance Committee provided an overview of items discussed at the 20 November meeting, and as a result the Board approved:
 - updated Risk Analysis Tables and Evaluation Criteria Consequences Assessment in respect of Finance and Budget categories;
 - the lease for the Yangebup Child Health Clinic and changing the Management Order on Crown Land at 34 Paget Street, Hilton from City of Fremantle to CAHS;
 - the Community Health Facilities Business Case for Midland for consideration in the 2019-10 Budget process; and

 the submission of the approximately \$30 million of Medical Equipment Replacement Program and Minor Works Expenditure over the next four years to be submitted to the System Manager.
