The fourth Board meeting for 2023 was held 4 May 2023 at Perth Children's Hospital (PCH) Boardroom.

SUMMARY OF THE BOARD MEETING

Chief Executive Report

The Board noted the Chief Executive Report and discussed:

- 1. CAHS Transformation Plan Implementation, noting the completion of the first bi-annual maturity matrix self-assessment.
- 2. Midland/Murdoch Community Hubs;
- 3. Electronic Medical Record (EMR) Business Case; and
- 4. Emergency Department Targets..

Consumer Engagement

The Youth Advisory Committee and the Consumer Advisory Committee minutes were noted from April 2023 with discussions regarding:

- Digital Medical Record Project;
- food availability for families after hours; and
- Consumer Engagement Strategy 2023-2026 and the approach of engaging children;
- improving awareness of the CAHS My Say survey; and
- access to sensory rooms within PCH.

Complaints and Compliments Report

The Board discussed the Consumer Experience moment as tabled and noted the compliments, including:

Board Committees
