

Insurance refers to a policy taken out to cover its own risks and liabilities. The party providing indemnity must have and maintain appropriate insurance. For commercially sponsored projects, the party responsible for this is the sponsor. For non-commercially sponsored projects, the responsible party is the WA Health System entity. For commercially sponsored projects, the details of the insurance must be in Schedule 4 of the Research Agreement.

Evidence of current Clinical Trial Insurance certificate of currency is required for all commercial projects. The RGO will also request a copy of the policy document to ensure the insurance is adequate and does not have any exclusions that may prevent a claim. Public liability insurance is required if study monitors will be coming onsite to monitor the project.
